Programs to participate in:

EG&CC offers extra programs to increase the value of your membership.

- 1 **2026 Tournament Schedule:** Team events and benefit tournaments have been scheduled in June, July, August, September and October on week days and some weekends.
- 2 **Regular Play:** Weekend and evenings are great times to play, with only a minimum of events scheduled on Saturdays or Sundays. On all event days, evening play is available after the completion of the event. Please ask at the clubhouse for details. Tee times are needed for the 2026 season by all golfers.
- 3 **Every Tuesday is Ladies' Day.** League begins in April and is a fun event for women of all abilities. A luncheon is served from 11:30 AM to 12:30 PM. Bridge and/or other card players are welcome to enjoy card games after the luncheon.
**Please note- Men members may golf with a women member all day, otherwise starting after 1 PM, but the practice green and the driving range is accessible all day. Visitors who pay green fees may play anytime. Tee times are needed for the 2026 season by all golfers.
- 4 **Every Wednesday is Men's Day.** Men's league starts with draft night beginning in May and league starting in mid- May. This is a fun event for men of all abilities. Must be 18 to participate. A weekly evening meal is available to men members and male guests. Serving starts at 6 PM. Sign-up helps the staff prepare food needs for the meal.
**Please note- Women and student members may be on the course until 3 PM, but the practice green and the driving range is accessible all day. Visitors who pay green fees may play anytime. Tee times are needed for the 2026 season by all golfers.
- 5 **Reciprocal card-** Members may play at other area participating courses for a discounted rate to experience neighboring golf courses. Ask at the counter for a membership card and a list of participating courses. Each golf course is responsible for their own reciprocal fees.

- 6 **Upstairs** – This space is available for rent, this space can be arranged with the clubhouse management team. Please ask about a reduced rental price for members.
- 7 **Guest golfing fees-** a golfing guest will be allowed to golf a total of 3 times during each yearly golfing season from April thru October. Single or Family golfing member must be present.

Members are encouraged and needed to help on clean-up days and tournament days. If you would like to volunteer, contact Ryan, Trevor or Adam.

PLEASE TAKE NOTE THAT THE FOLLOWING RULES ARE STRONGLY ENFORCED

- All players must register for tee times prior to playing, INCLUDING members. This is for safety and course use reasons.
- Elkader Golf & Country Club has an Iowa Class C Retail Alcohol License which covers the clubhouse and golf course. Iowa's Alcoholic Beverages Division, Iowa Code 123.46 states it is illegal to bring alcoholic beverages on to our licensed Iowa premise. Members or guests violating Code 123.46 puts EG&CC liquor license in jeopardy for suspension or revocation.

All outside alcoholic beverages will be confiscated and disposed.

- All carts must always remain 30 feet from the edge of the greens.
- Repair all divots and ball marks, and rake traps. Use sand mix on Par 3 tees and provided sand mix bottles on EG&CC rental carts. Please care for trees and do not litter.
- Shirt and shoes must be worn at all times.
- Each golfer must have a set of clubs. Rentals are available.
- Anyone operating an EG&CC motorized rental cart must be 16 years of age and have a valid driver's license.
- Children aged **3-4 years** old may only ride (rental & member-owned) with their parents in a motorized golf cart. They are not permitted to play or use golf clubs on the golf course. Parents assume all responsibilities for their children's safe conduct and safety while on the golf course and around the clubhouse.
- Young golfers **5-10 years** old can golf on the golf course when accompanied by a parent/adult who assumes all responsibilities for the child's golf etiquette, safe conduct and safety. From age **7-10**, young golfers can operate **their parent member-owned motorized carts** with the on-board supervision of the parent/adult cart owner. The adult cart owner assumes all responsibilities, damages, and liabilities while the cart is operated by this age group of children.
- Young golfers **11-16 years** old can golf on the golf course without an adult, these young golfers must follow golf etiquette guidelines like all golfers while on the golf course and around the clubhouse. From age **14-16** young golfers may operate **parent/member-owned motorized carts** without an adult rider. The adult golf cart owner assumes all responsibilities, damages, and liabilities while the cart is operated by this group of young golfers.
- Guest fees rates are honored only when a single or family adult golfing member is present. A golfing guest will be allowed to golf a total of 3 times during each yearly golfing season from April thru October.
- Please respect all workers, volunteers, and other golfers.
- PGA Rule 7-1b for Tournaments: In stroke play, a person cannot practice on the course before they play a round, or between rounds of a multi-day competition played on consecutive days. This includes putting on the greens. Note: A person can chip or putt on the practice green. (This rule does not pertain to the Glow Golf tournaments.)
- Men's League- the first round played is the round scored!
- Please follow golf etiquette! Also listed in handbook.
- **GOLFING GROUPS-** Foursome golfing groups are preferred, **fivesomes** are allowed some days with prior approval from clubhouse staff. **NO sixsomes or larger** groups are allowed at any time (**unless** arranged by staff for special 3-person best ball groups). Play should begin on Hole #1 most

days, unless the clubhouse staff decides that dividing larger golfing groups on selected holes will improve the pace of golf on the course.

- All golfing groups will allow faster groups to play through to maintain normal golfing pace. Elkader Golf and Country Club needs guest greens fee paying golfer to maintain our 9 hole golf course. Sometimes green fee golfers come in larger numbers as a group to experience our golf course. Members please extend Northeast Iowa hospitality to our guests.

Clubhouse Hours

The Clubhouse opens for golfing on or before April 1st and closes on October 31st. Opening is at 9 AM in April, September, and October; May-August will be 8 AM. Last call will be 10:45 PM (Wednesday) unless there is a night activity, otherwise the clubhouse will close ½ hour after sunset. Course play is allowed on either side of these dates as long as flags are in the holes, and weather/course conditions permitting.

A golf family can include one/two persons living at the same residence and all single children still residing at that residence and not gainfully employed up to 21 years of age. It also includes those still enrolled in the first 5 consecutive years of college and shall include all single children in military service.

A single membership entitles one person per membership to golfing and/or non-golfing privileges. A student membership regular or Central student – golfing only; no guest privileges.

Dues Payable

Dues are payable as soon as invoices are sent and are due before March 1^{5th} Dues are delinquent after May 1st, and membership privileges are suspended and will only be reinstated upon payment of all dues.

The parent will bear total financial and liability responsibility for the rental cart operated by their student. Parents may be asked to provide proof of homeowners liability insurance. Any operational offense will result in termination of cart use without refund.

Must be 18 years old to participate in all tournaments administered by the club except for benefit events.

All tournaments are 18 holes unless specified.

Reminder: In stroke play, you can't practice on the course before you play a round, or between rounds of a multi-day competition played on consecutive days (USGA Rule 7-1b). Penalty is disqualification. You may use the practice green.

If you would like to participate in a tournament but you don't have a partner or a team, please put your name and number in the 3-ring binder that is kept on the counter in the clubhouse so others know to contact you.

Golf Etiquette

- Everyone needs a tee time from the clubhouse before going to the first tee block. If you booked a tee time online, you must complete checking in at the clubhouse. If you do this, you will be aware of any special rules that apply that day and the clubhouse staff will be aware of who is on the course in case someone needs to be contacted or in an emergency.
- Start your round of golf at Hole #1. Please stay back from the group ahead of you to be courteous and not rush them. **PLUS**, it's never courteous to cut in front of anyone on Hole #4 and jump in at Hole #5 (especially if we can see them on #4 from the Clubhouse.)
- Return coolers to the Clubhouse!!! Also bring back the range ball bags!
- Obey all cart path rules and signs. **Observe the 90° rule.** Drive carts in the rough as much as possible, staying off the fairway whenever possible and never drive closer than 30 ft. from the green. 2 golfers in each cart, whenever possible to save wear on the course.
- NO talking when others are hitting. Stay off your phone and make no comments when another player is addressing the ball. Always be encouraging of others after they hit their ball. Say "great shot" only if it was.
- Do not move or stand behind someone on the green. Make sure you are off to the side. Do not stand across from another player behind the hole or cause your shadow to cross their path to the hole.
- Be careful where you walk on the green. It's rude to walk in a fellow player's line from their ball to the hole. Do not walk in the through line (the line past the hole if they go long).
- Lost Ball Etiquette- Since 2019, the rules of golf permit you 3 minutes to locate a wayward ball. It's always wise to watch other's tee offs and verbalize where it dropped- especially if in the rough. If the ball is heading toward other golfers, please yell "FORE".
- Always be ready to take your turn to hit the ball. The person's ball that's farthest from the hole has honors. For tee off in tournaments, the person with the lowest score on the previous hole has honors. For everyday golf, play to keep players moving, the person ready first is free to tee off first.
- Allow faster groups to play through. If you notice another group behind you has moved closely behind you and is waiting a long time to make their next play, then go back to them at the next tee

box and give them the opportunity to play ahead of you. However, if you are keeping up to a group ahead of you, ignore this courtesy.

- No playing/practicing on the course before a tournament=disqualification. Use the driving range or practice green. (USGA Rule 7-1b)
- Play in groups no more than 4- **UNLESS** approval first from the clubhouse.

The Acorns

The Acorns is the auxiliary organization that serves the women of the country club and provides programming for them. The group has provided funding each year for needed items at the club. Business meetings are generally held the last Tuesday of the month.

Women's programming includes:

Tuesday golf and luncheons with cards after lunch; luncheons are served every Tuesday from 11:30-12:30. Women are not only welcome but encouraged to bring guests for lunch. Please notify the club or the Acorns president if you are bringing guests.

Carry outs may be ordered ahead to be certain of having one or may be requested after lunch if there is food available.
